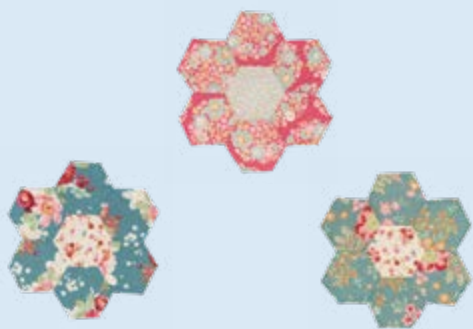
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HOME SWEET HOME SEWING

Home Sweet Home Sewing is a collection of sweet and fresh new projects inspired by the traditional crafts of patchwork, quilting and embroidery but with a contemporary twist which makes them fit well in modern interiors.

I have explored my love of fabrics here too, and show ways to use up even the tiniest scraps. I love to use a special fabric colour palette to create the different projects, from soft and romantic to bright and fresh, and exploring colour is a way to make each project your own. I learnt how to do patchwork using the English paper piecing technique when I was a school girl. I love to sew by hand still, but I also appreciate the speed of machine sewing and chain piecing and I have included projects for all these in my new book.

The selection of projects includes the soft and floral Honey Hives Quilt and the cute Little Houses Quilt, as well as the very sweet Little Birds Doll's Quilt that includes simple embroidery. There are lots of smaller makes like patchwork cushions, including the Liberty Circles Cushion that uses up tiny precious scraps of fabric, the pretty pastel Spring Wreath, cute Little Deer toy, handstitched pincushions and other sewing notions, table topper, pretty fabric bags, coasters, charms and decorations. Many of these simple patterns provide a good starting point to explore your own creativity, and I hope they will inspire you to create and have a lot of crafty fun.

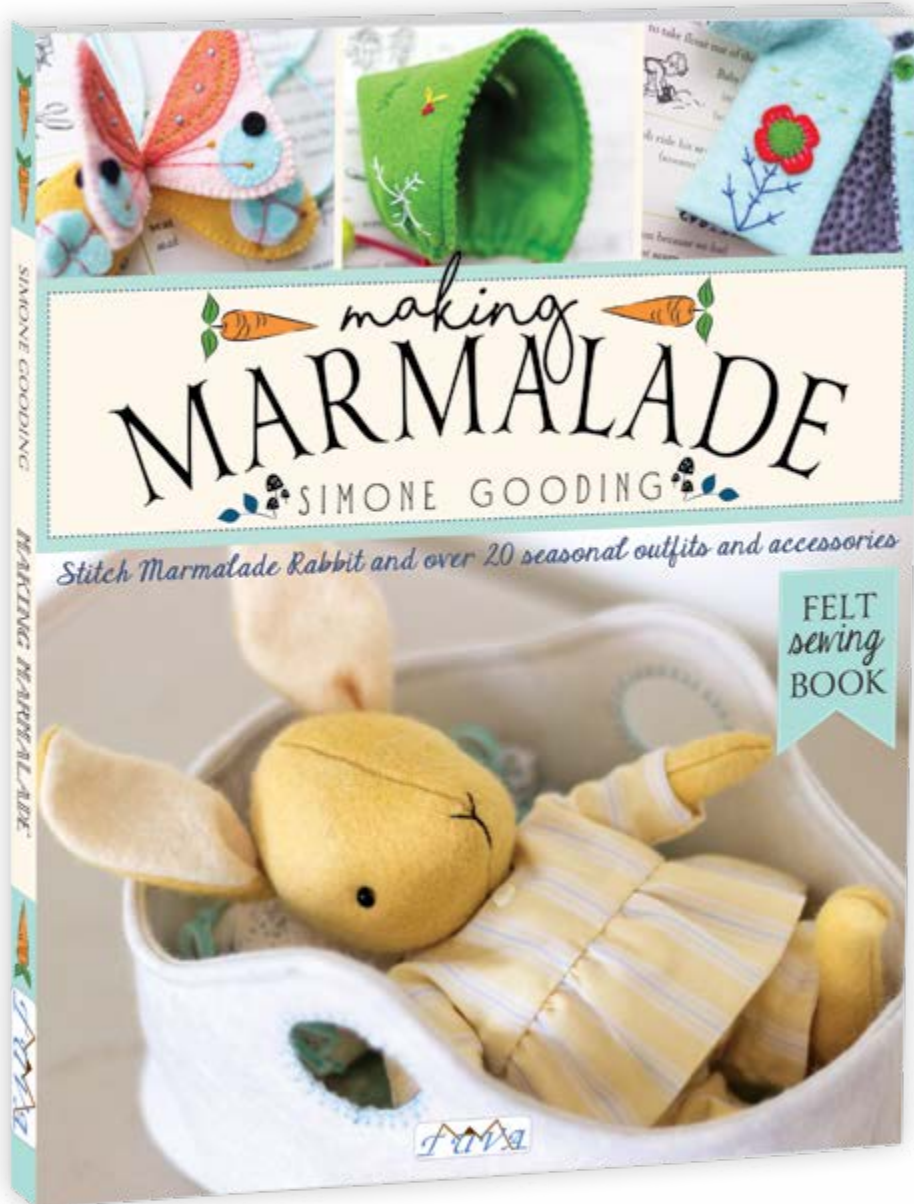

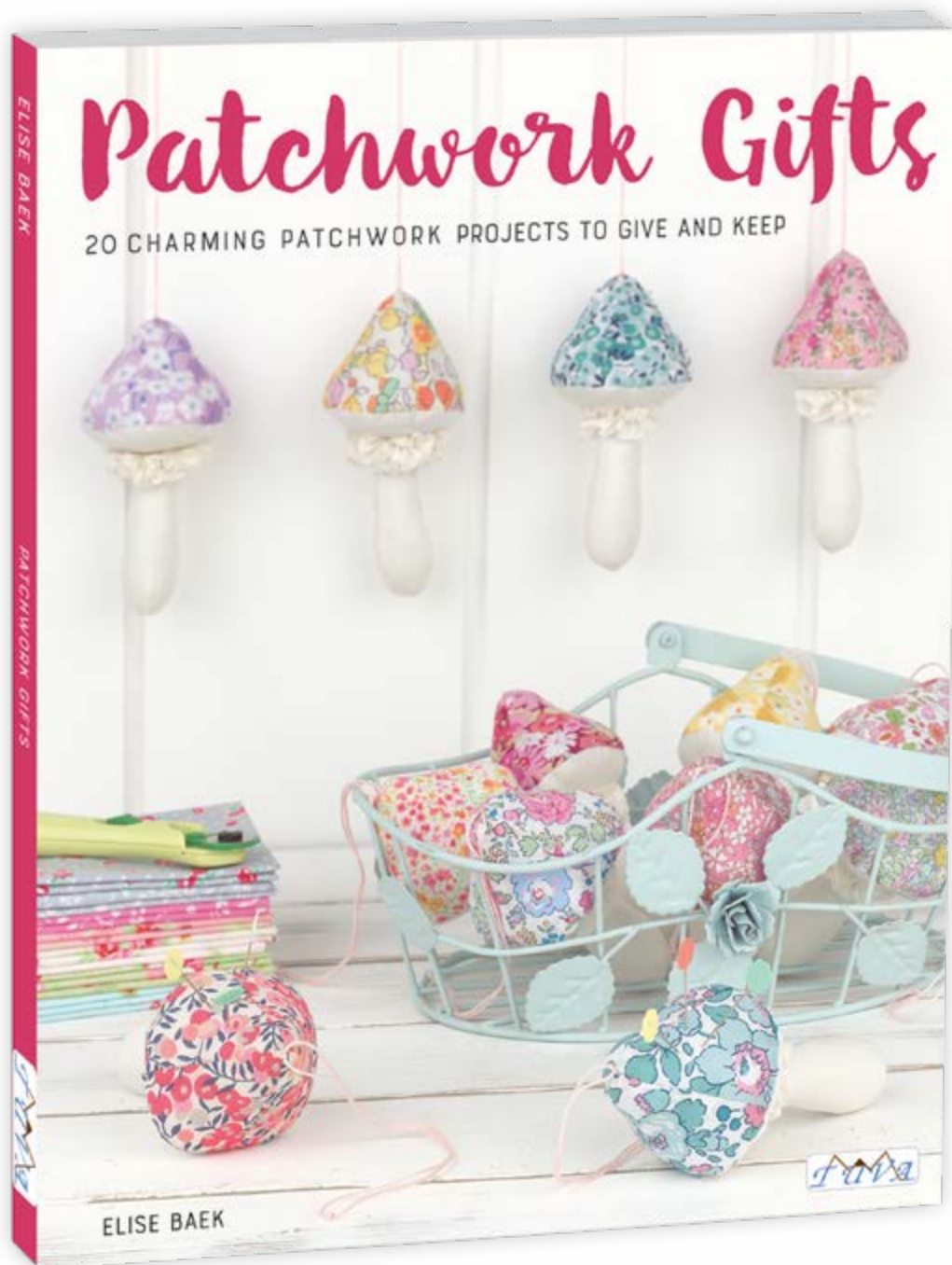

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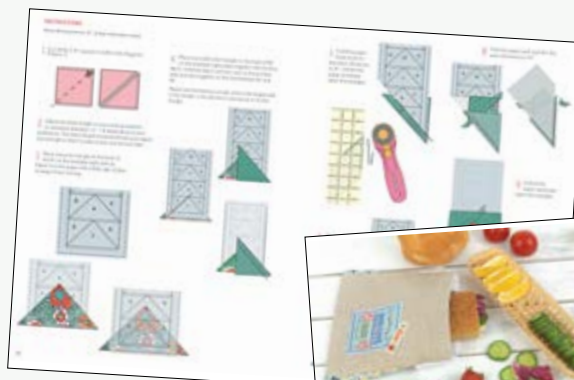
PATCHWORK GIFTS

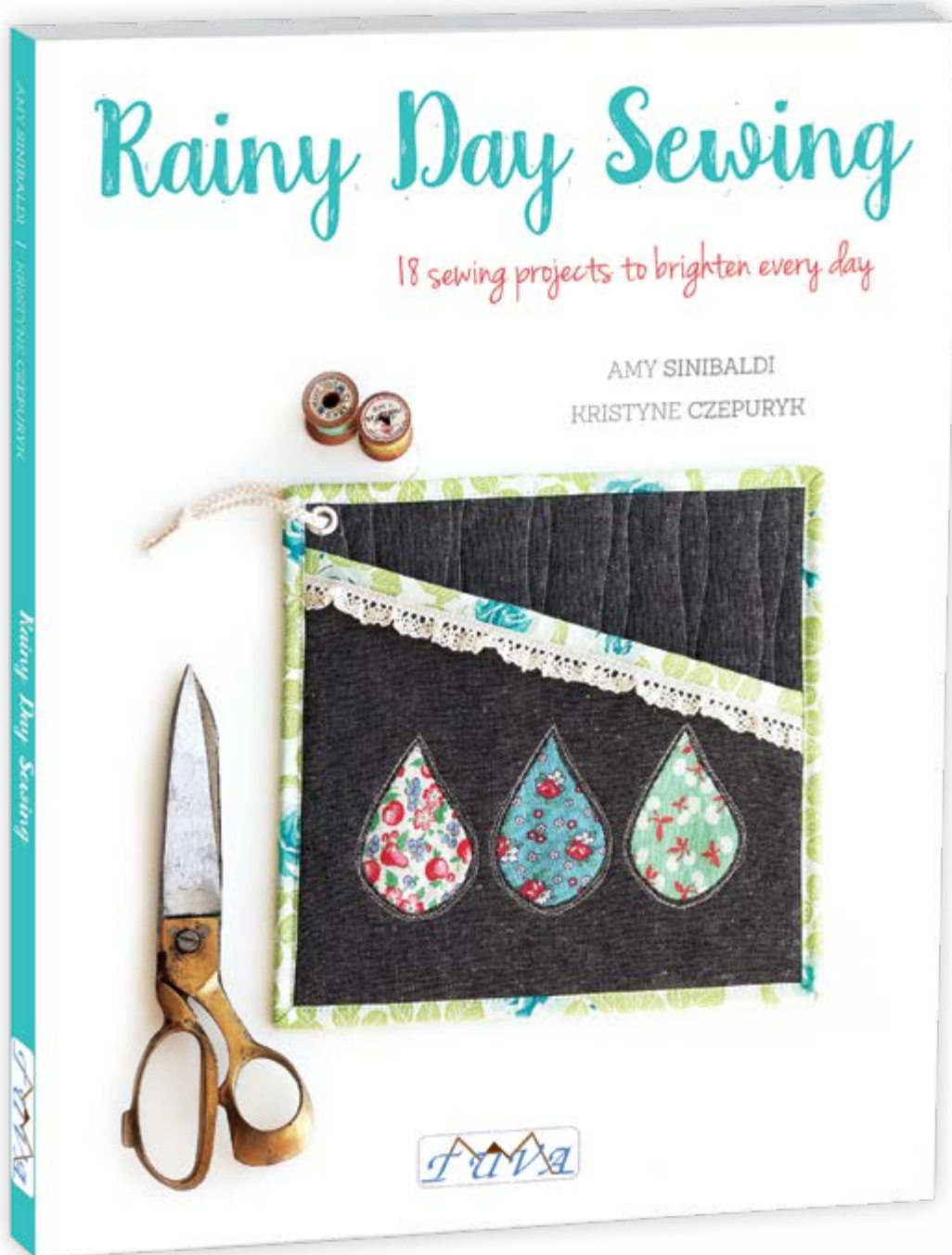

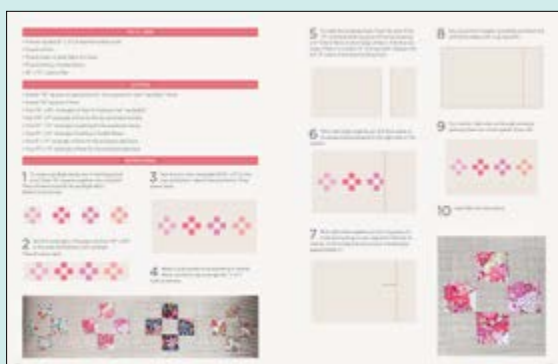

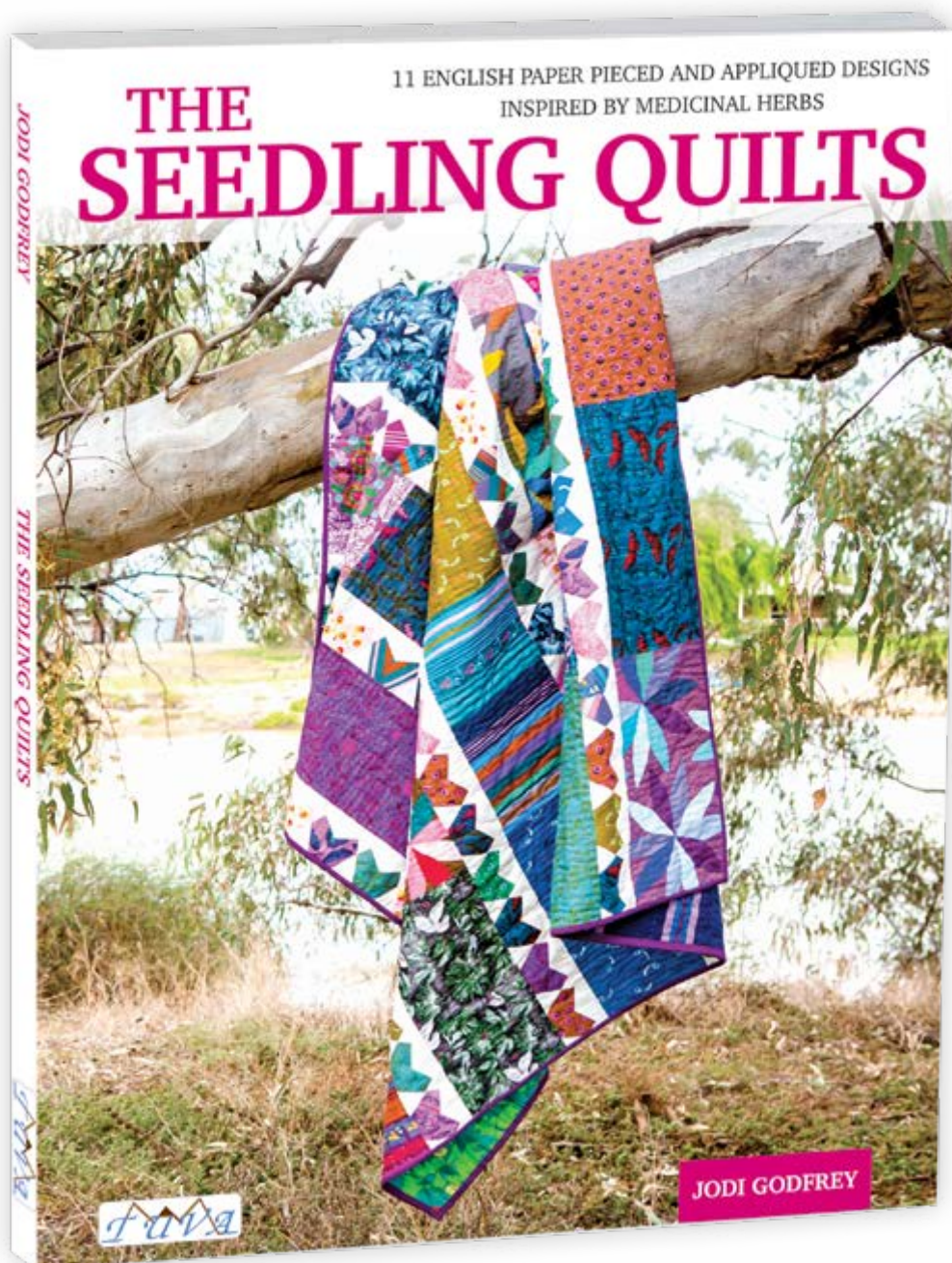

THE SEEDLING QUILTS

This book includes 10 English Paper Pieced designs and 11 quilts. Seedlings, the inspiration quilt, is made up of panels of each of the designs in a medallion/log cabin format. Each chapter offers a pattern for both the Seedlings panel, and the stand-alone quilt inspired by it. You'll find the final instructions for sewing the Seedlings panels together in the last chapter.

For this book, I have played with different elements of quilt-making, mixing EPP with appliqué and machine piecing. Sometimes, while stitching the quilts, I discovered that mixing up the traditional order of things made the construction simpler, so I occasionally appliquéd pieces after basting the quilt sandwich rather than before, or machine stitched them to a pieced quilt top. Be sure to read the instructions through first before starting your quilt to avoid unnecessary challenges!

All the quilts in this book were made from stash except for Lavender Quilt (fabric supplied by Art Gallery Fabrics) and Caraway Quilt (Fabric bought from Polka Dot Tea). I wanted to make sure these quilts felt a little timeless, and able to be made by anyone with a scrap collection. I hope they make you feel like you can dive right in! MODERN QUILTS

This book celebrates my love of block based quilts. I've found myself making many repeating block based quilts over the years without even realizing it. Block based quilts are versatile, easy to make and usually use smaller precuts of fabric such as fat quarters.

Many of the blocks in this book are what I like to call mix and match quilts. You start with a fat quarter bundle and each block uses 2-3 fabrics from the bundle. You can mix and match them until they are all used up.

Block based quilts are fun to design and a good place to start when thinking up your own quilt patterns. Most blocks are general sizes such as 6in, 9in, 12in or 15in. Each block can then be divided into grids making the design process simple. Not all blocks in this book follow that rule of thumb and some are unique sizes.

I like the clean crisp look of a good repeating block. They usually give your eye plenty of places to rest especially when using a neutral like white as your background fabric. You will find 11 modern quilt block designs to try out. Make each quilt individually or try each block and piece together a sampler quilt with those blocks.

Modern Quilts Block by Block is for any skill level of quilter. Once you learn the basics of quilting you should be able to tackle any project in this book. I believe quilts are meant to be used and loved. Let go of your perfectionism when it comes to quilting and just enjoy the process. Quilts around here are laundered frequently and snuggled under often. The more worn and loved a quilt becomes, the better.

I am very pleased to bring you my latest book of cross stitch motifs, which focuses on very small cross stitch designs. 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MODERN PUNCH NEEDLE

It's not unusual to see throwbacks to past trends in the worlds of fashion and home decor but such throwbacks also occur in the field of craft. A craft that enjoyed great popularity in days gone by can sometimes be forgotten, only to enjoy a revival as it's taken up again. My discovery of punch needle embroidery, which dates back to the Middle Ages, was thanks to such a revival. Although the history of punch needle is obscure, it's thought it is possible to trace its origins to rug hooking techniques in medieval times or even as far back as the ancient Egyptians. This age-old skill has been growing in popularity in the last 10 years and is now taking its place in contemporary craft again.

I have tried my hand at many different crafts over the years and would definitely call myself a 'DIY-er'. When I see something new, I want to try it out, but very few of the crafts I've had a go at have become a passion – until I met the punch needle! Little did I imagine that the punch needle I bought in order to shoot a video for my YouTube channel would turn out to be one of the loves of my life! Printed on the packaging of that first punch needle were these words "It is easy to start, impossible to stop!" – a statement that turned out to be completely true for me.
